- I. Call to order 12:03pm
- II. Approval of April minutes Judi Davis motioned, Julie seconded, all in favor
- III. Suggested changes to bi-laws
 - A. Change *College* to *University* throughout: Julie motioned for approval, Joe seconded, all in favor, one abstention
 - B. Move the Science Ed TEC representative seat from the School of Arts & Sciences to the School of Education (currently, the Bylaws indicate that A&S holds 6 TEC seats, reflecting 6 programs, but A&S now houses 5 programs; the SOE's TEC seats should accordingly increase by 1; this was not done when the Science Ed program relocated Schools); Julie motion for approval, Judi Davis seconded, all in favor, no abstentions
 - C. The bi-laws state that there are 3 standing committees; however, 4 are mentioned under that heading in the bi-laws (Assessment and Accreditation, Field/Clinical Experience, Faculty Development, and Recruitment and Retention); currently, Professional Development is not in place as a standing committee; Shannon added a discussion point (professional development work is being subsumed by TEUPAC (PDS)); the question was posed whether or not to revive the PD committee or keep its duties as part of TEUPAC (PDS); Julie proposed not reviving the separate PD committee; Julie motioned to approve, Joe seconded, all in favor
- IV. TEC secretary position proposal to "round-robin" minutes so that each department representative will take minutes once during the TEC year; if a representative is absent during their assigned date, they must send a representative in their place to take the minutes
 - A. Discussion: Julie noted concern; Judy D., indicated that she felt she couldn't keep up with the level of minutes; Terri noted that a template would be provided, along with PowerPoints that could be referenced in the minutes

In less than two weeks IGPE's IPDS Germany program will welcome to Buffalo our 5th exchange cohort from our partner university in Nürtingen; this group of 7 teacher candidates and 2 program leaders will live with host families and partner with area teachers; new to this year's visit is the development of an "education exchange" on May 25 at 10 AM in Bacon 217; the German students will provide a presentation about the education system, schools, and teaching in Germany and SOE faculty and students will provide the same overview of education in the U.S.; the presentations will be followed by an informal discussion for all; anyone interested is invited to join
