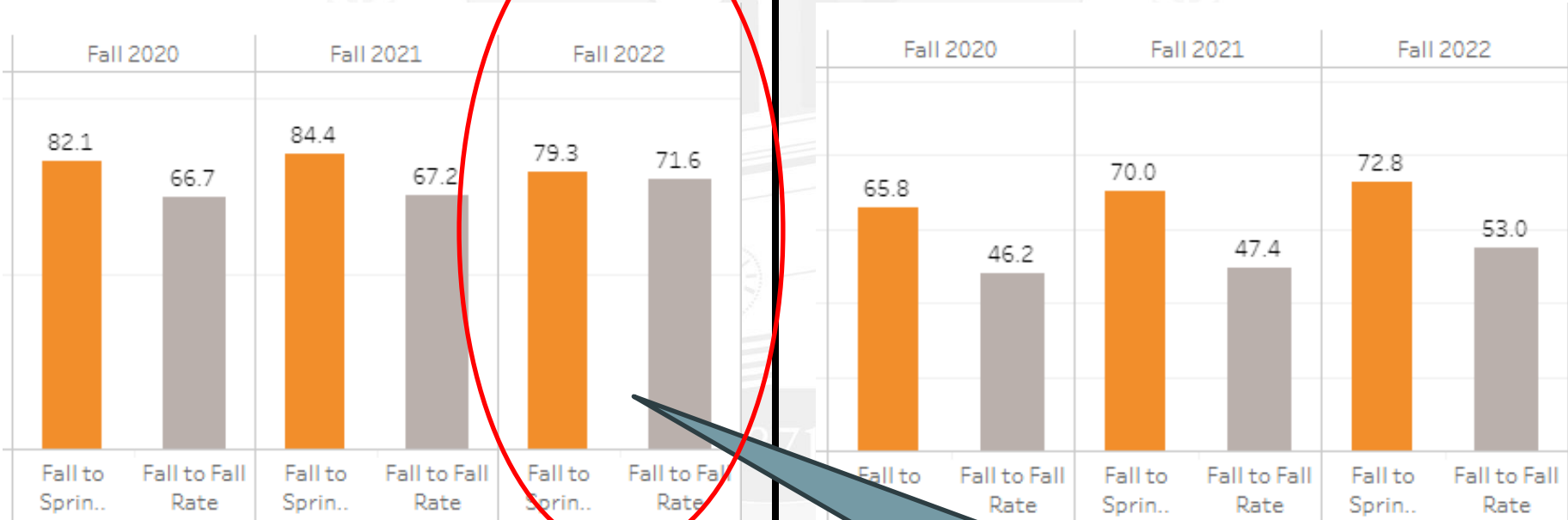
Persistence & Retention TEU vs Non-TEU (BSC w/o TEU included)

Potsdam: 91% (2019) *small numbers

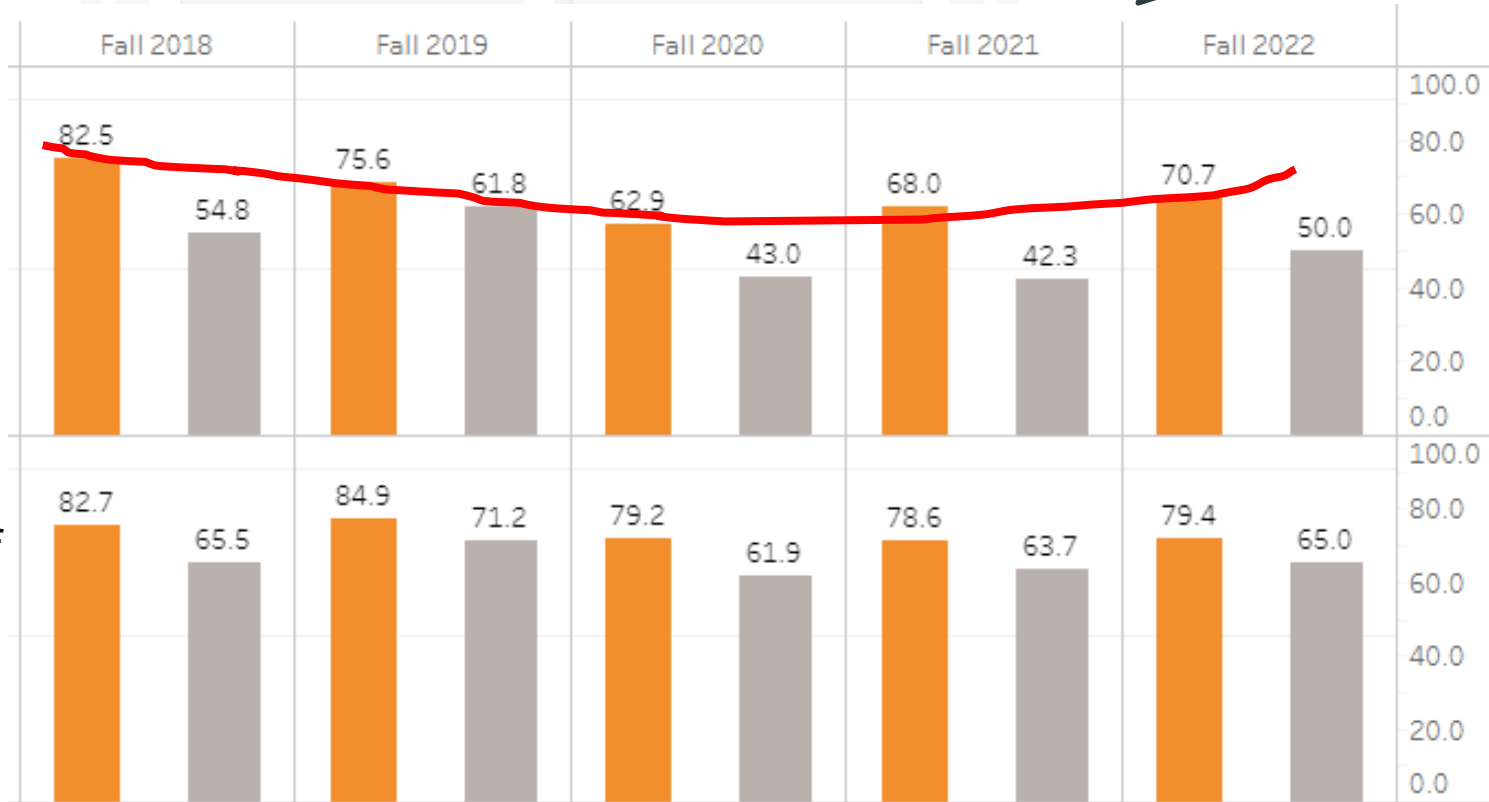
Last year, our **persistence dropped** but our **retention increased**.

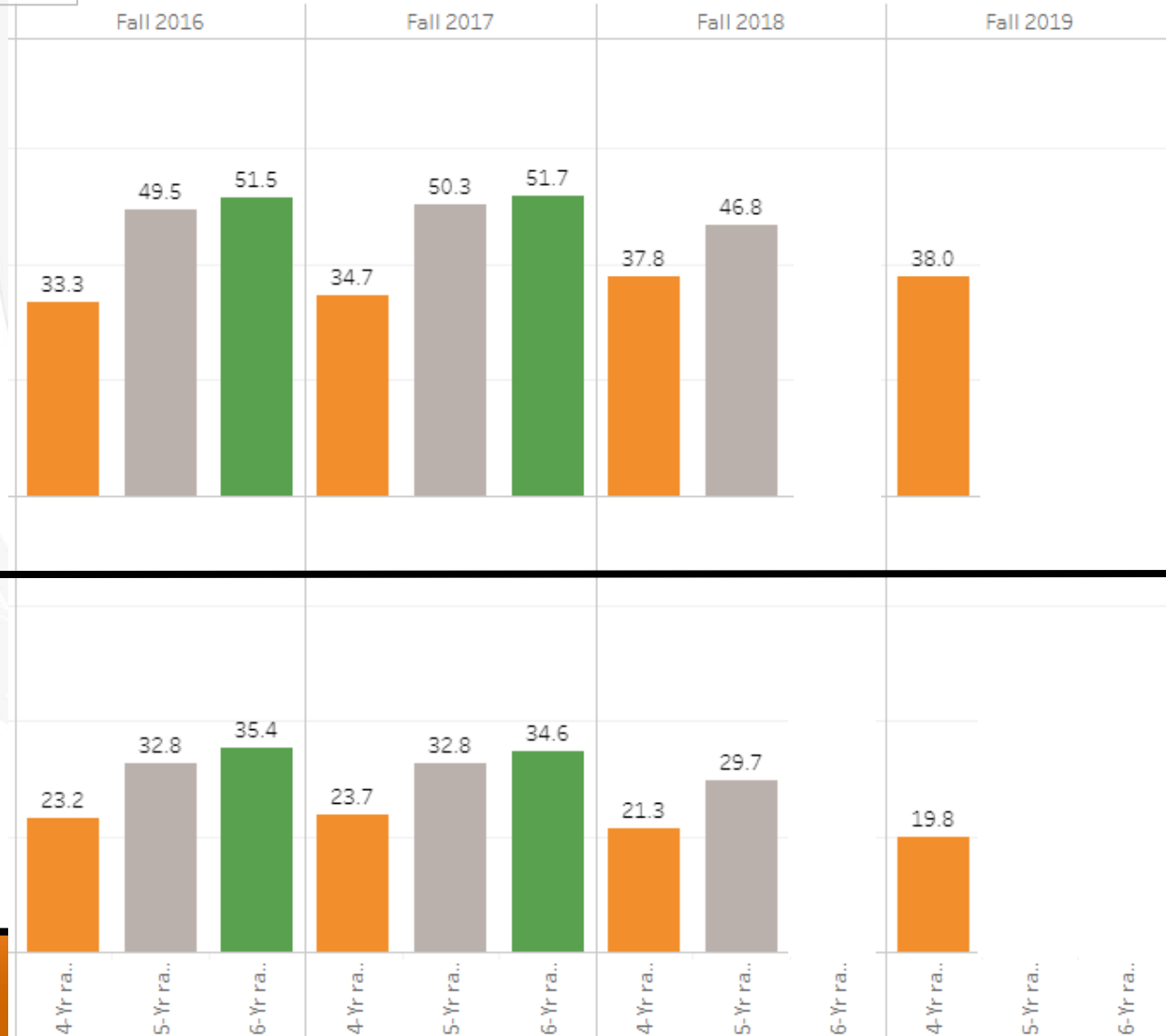
