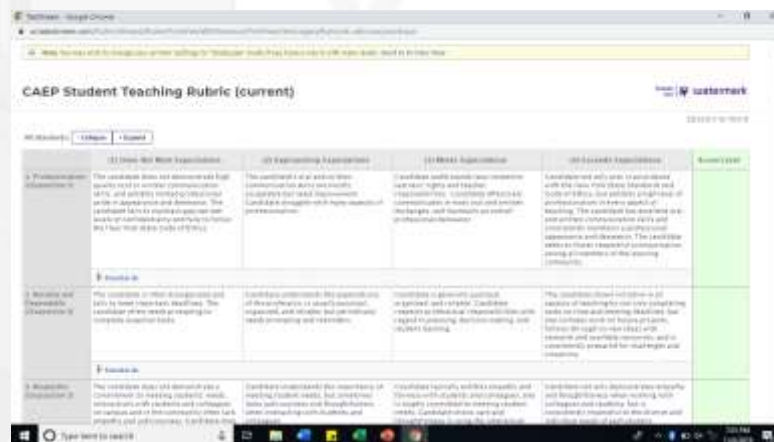

Final Practicum Evaluation

- Administered during student teaching.
- Combines dispositions & pedagogical knowledge/skills
- Completed by **supervisor** on Taskstream as a rubric.
 - Prompted by candidate who completes a survey, generating an email to supervisor to complete the assessment.
- Completed by **mentor teacher**
 - using a “link” sent to them as a survey



Summary of Findings

Out of **4 point scale**, mean ratings for **DISPOSITIONS** were:

INITIAL PROGRAMS-

- **3.71** or higher (mentor)
Range 2-4 (per item)
N=311
- **3.54** or higher (supervisor)
Range 1-4 (per item)
N=259

ADVANCED PROGRAMS-

- **4.0** (mentor)
Range 4-4 (per item)
N=8
- **3.45** or higher (supervisor)
Range 2-4 (per item)
N=53

Summary of Findings

Out of **4 point scale**, mean ratings for **PEDAGOGICAL KNOWLEDGE & SKILLS** were:

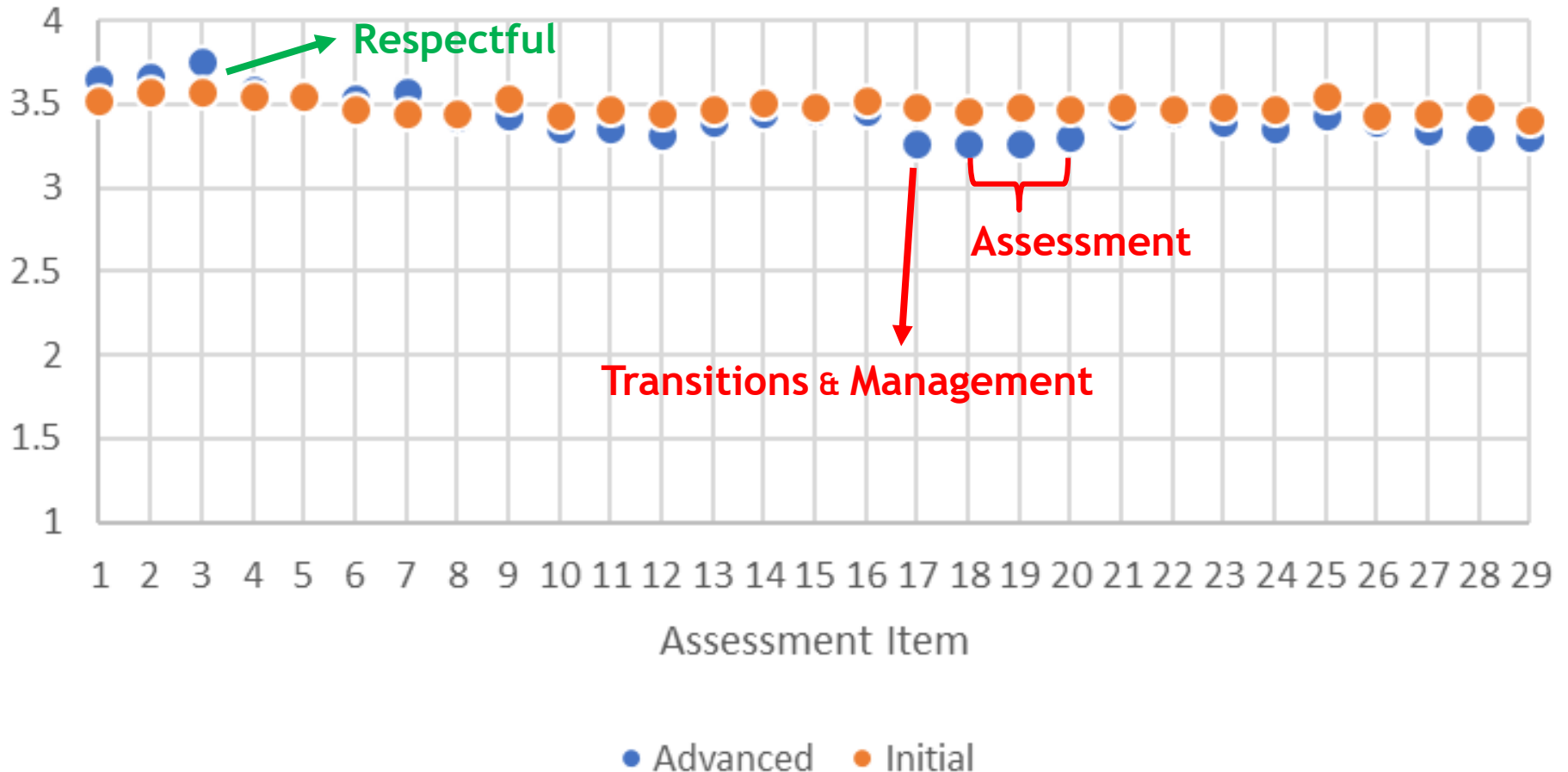

- **3.36** (supervisor)
Range 1-4 (per item)
N=259

ADVANCED PROGRAMS-

- **3.85** (mentor)

Range 2-4 (per item)
- N=8

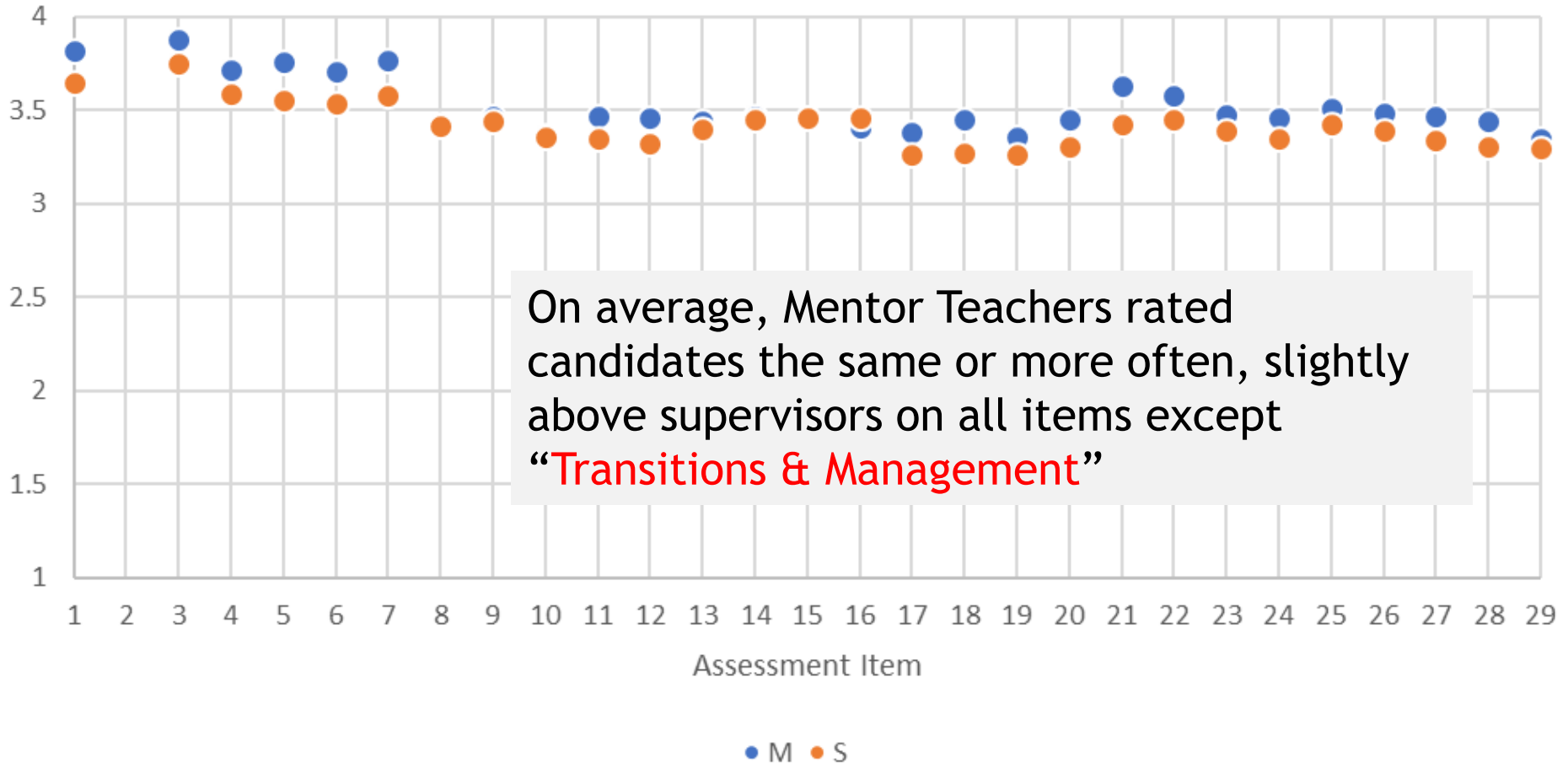

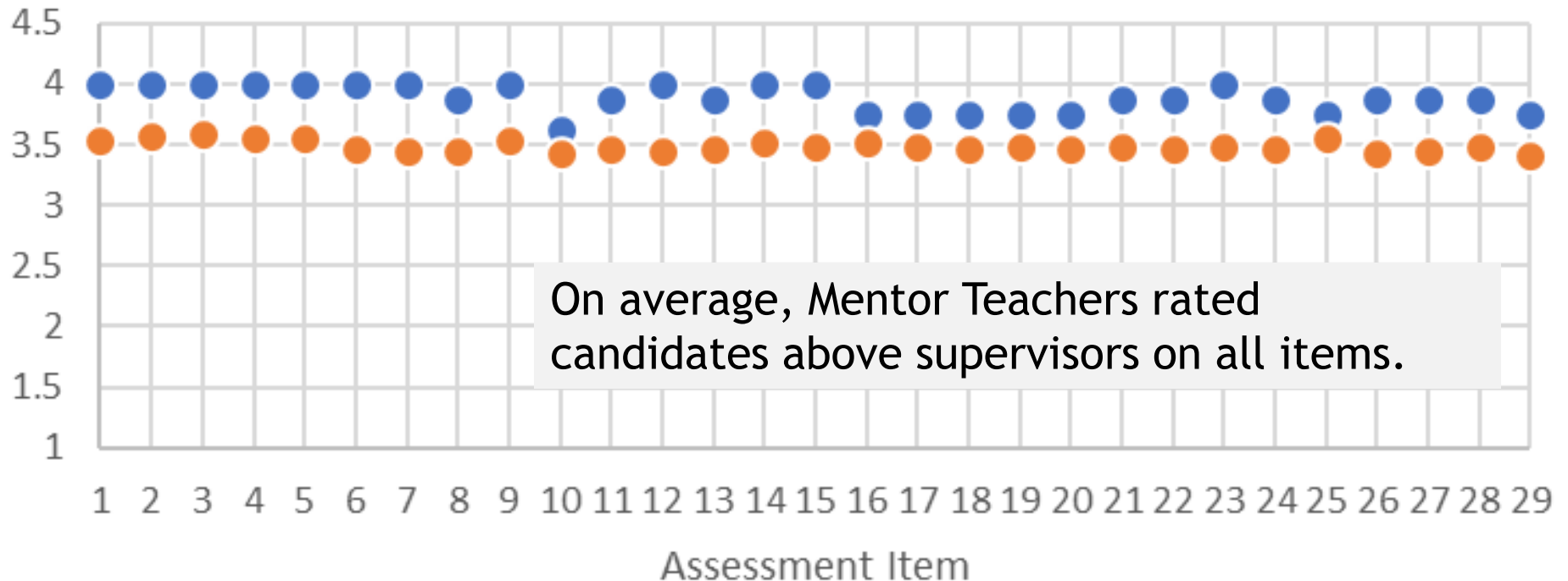
Comparing Mentor Teacher Data to College Supervisor Data

Good results (some inconsistent participation)

- Not all initial programs are having supervisors evaluate using Final Practicum Evaluation on Taskstream

311 evaluations completed

(7 programs participated)

117, 170, 14 student teachers

- Of those programs who ARE evaluating, not all supervisors are completing it

Summary, overall....

- On average, candidates “**met expectations**” in all areas of pedagogical knowledge, skills, and dispositions.
- Candidate ratings for Initial and Advanced Programs generally consistent.
- Mentor teachers may tend to rate slightly higher compared to supervisors.
- Submission rates could improve (within and across programs)
