- III. TEC Membership

 1. Set to meet on Nov 18, 2016
- V. Unit Head Report (Wendy Paterson)
 - A. Cross-disciplinary Connections: Student-led suggestions for collaboration – English Students Association
 1. PDS committee, student rep, student report
 - a. Shared grievance - Pertaining to potential for students gain experience if educations can be bridged
 - b. Public speaking suggestion – creating public speaking workshop
 2. Dr. Paterson summarized
 - a. Dr. Paterson will be hosting a joint teacher candidate club event
 - b. Short term IPDS activities are open to all teacher ed. candidates
 - i. Being sure to advertise to all majors IPDS activities
 - ii. Example, Chili trip
 - c. Need to find a curricular activity to coincide with the above-mentioned collaboration.
 - i. May have opportunity to offer a freshman class
 - ii. Education themed classes
 - iii. Class: ED 203 may be a class to be opened to other majors
 - iv. Elementary and secondary education do tend to get segregated, unintentionally
 - v. Suggestion: perhaps a capstone would bring students together form different disciplines
 - B. Working with Depew – to establish a program where graduate students can get two days of paid work as a sub, while working with a supervising teacher during the rest of the week. This type of program is working well in Rochester.
 - C. Every Student Success Act (ESSA) – New No Child Left Behind. ESSA – high concept ideas. Basic ideas about federal vs. states rights. Federal government putting more power in the state’s hands. More information can be found on NYS.gov. There is a period of public comment, so comments can be made.
- VI. Certification Office update (15 minutes – 1:45 – 2:00) (Patty Recchio)
 - A. Student email,
 1. Students should provide emails that they will be keeping after they graduate
 2. Students should check their email
 - B. NYS edTPA Task Force Meeting
 1. Complaint – safety nets are implemented, but by the time they expire, nothing will have been done to rectify the issues originally causing the safety net to be in place.
 2. A taskforce meeting will take place next week.
 - C. CST Safety Net update,
 1. No clear way to communicate safety nets – State website is inaccurate – See Patty
 2. New changes, involving many dates are not changed on the website yet.
 3. Action by board of regents in October.

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- i. Old: Any specialty revised has the old version of the content specialty test as the safety net.
 - ii. New: Can take the revised safety net or an additional option
 4. State: Childhood educators can take the old safety net version of the multi-subject exam; however, when going to register, they can't register
 5. State: New state policy does not include the multi-subject; however, NYSUT says it does include multi-subject
 6. See Patty Recchio for clarification of the above.
 - D. ALST Safety Net update,
 1. For someone who has completed all requirements for certification, but waiting for ALST
 2. Students must request a transcription and have an attestation form, if going through Patty's office, then State Ed will accept.
